What is a Jubilee Year?

A Jubilee Year is a special time in the Church’s tradition encouraging holiness through acts of reconciliation and communion with our brothers and sisters. Jubilee Year 2025 will be marked by special opportunities for grace through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, local pilgrimages and the Jubilee Indulgence. The theme is “Pilgrims of Hope”.

Pilgrimage Sites in western Oregon

One of the most important observances of a Jubilee Year is pilgrimage, recalling the need for silence and recollection, forming friendships with fellow travelers, and seeking Christ, who is the way and the gateway to eternal life. Knowing that very few of us can travel to Rome to pass through the jubilee’s Holy Doors, Archbishop Sample has designated 10 pilgrimage sites throughout the Archdiocese, where the faithful will be able to pray and unite themselves spiritually with all pilgrims.

A YEAR OF SPIRITUAL RENEWAL AND GRACE

The Jubilee Indulgence is a special grace offered during a Holy Year, freeing the faithful from the spiritual effects of past sins. To receive it, Catholics must be truly repentant, go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, pray for the Pope’s intentions, and perform a spiritual act such as a pilgrimage, charitable work, or dedicated prayer.

How to Receive the Jubilee Indulgence:

- *Pilgrimages:* Visit a designated sacred site chosen by the local bishop. Participate in Mass, pray the Rosary, meditate on the Scriptures, or join in Eucharistic Adoration.
- *Acts of Mercy and Charity:* Help those in need by performing acts of kindness like feeding the hungry, visiting the sick, or supporting charities. These acts count when done with sincere love and repentance.
- *Prayer from Home:* If you are unable to travel due to illness, age, or confinement, you can still receive the indulgence by praying at home, following Mass through media, and offering your struggles to God.

By fulfilling these spiritual and charitable acts with a heart open to God’s mercy, Catholics can receive the Jubilee Indulgence, experiencing forgiveness and spiritual renewal. **Archbishop Sample has designated the following sites as official pilgrimage places to receive a Jubilee Indulgence in western Oregon:**

¿Qué es un año de jubileo?

Un Año Jubilar es un momento especial en la tradición de la Iglesia que fomenta la santidad a través de actos de reconciliación y comunión con nuestros hermanos y hermanas. El Año Jubilar 2025 estará marcado por oportunidades especiales de gracia a través del Sacramento de la Reconciliación, las peregrinaciones locales y la Indulgencia Jubilar. El tema es “Peregrinos de la Esperanza”.

Sitios de peregrinación en el oeste de Oregón

Una de las celebraciones más importantes de un Año Jubilar es la peregrinación, recordando la necesidad de silencio y recogimiento, formando amistad con los compañeros de viaje y buscando a Cristo, que es el camino y la puerta a la vida eterna. Sabiendo que muy pocos de nosotros podemos viajar a Roma para atravesar las Puertas Santas del jubileo, el Arzobispo Sample ha designado 10 lugares de peregrinación en toda la Arquidiócesis, donde los fieles podrán orar y unirse espiritualmente con todos los peregrinos.

UN AÑO DE RENOVACIÓN ESPIRITUAL Y GRACIA

La Indulgencia Jubilar es una gracia especial ofrecida durante un Año Santo, que libera a los fieles de los efectos espirituales de los pecados pasados. Para recibirlo, los católicos deben estar verdaderamente arrepentidos, confesarse, recibir la Sagrada Comunión, orar por las intenciones del Papa y realizar un acto espiritual como una peregrinación, una obra caritativa o una oración dedicada.

Cómo recibir la indulgencia jubilar:

- Peregrinaciones: Visite un lugar sagrado designado y elegido por el obispo local. Participe en la Misa, rece el Rosario, medite en las Escrituras o únase a la Adoración Eucarística.
- Actos de Misericordia y Caridad: Ayude a los necesitados realizando actos de bondad como alimentar a los hambrientos, visitar a los enfermos o apoyar a organizaciones benéficas. Estos actos cuentan cuando se hacen con amor y arrepentimiento sinceros.
- Oración desde casa: si no puedes viajar debido a enfermedad, edad o confinamiento, aún puedes recibir la indulgencia orando en casa, siguiendo la Misa a través de los medios de comunicación y ofreciendo tus luchas a Dios.

Al realizar estos actos espirituales y caritativos con un corazón abierto a la misericordia de Dios, los católicos pueden recibir la Indulgencia Jubilar, experimentando el perdón y la renovación espiritual.
