Memory from Fergus Loughran

As I reflect on the 150th anniversary, I realize that my family now has over three decades here. It's hard to believe, but when we joined the parish in 1990, Tammy and I were engaged. I was working in Astoria while Tammy finished college and we married the week after she graduated from Willamette University where I had also attended.

The last thirty years are filled with so many great memories of so many years of working with other parish families to decorate the church for Christmas. Our children had their Baptisms, first Reconciliation, first Holy Communions, Confirmations, and two wedding here in St. Mary's. All three of our children attended Star of the Sea School until it closed when the youngest was in seventh grade. The announcement of the school closure brought our whole family to tears that Sunday.

We loved our years in the school. I recently read a written memory of an alumni from 1945-57 who spoke of "the boxy, three-story building with no significant architectural style. The plainness of the building belied the magic and education that was taking place inside." I couldn't agree more. I remember standing in the school one advent morning

while the whole student body had morning prayer and sang "Oh Come O Come Emanuel," and thought this is the beauty of Star of the Sea. Our children had a great childhood because of Star; and Star definitely provided a strong foundation for them in both education and faith.

We also treasure the years we have been privileged to work with the parish youth –to be a part of so many kids' Confirmations and to see altar servers we worked with from second grade to high school graduation. Those time were always emotional for us.

I also can't say enough about great parishioners we have known who I am sure are home in heaven. People like Alice Turina, Don and Marie Rummel, Bill Leahy, Joanne Webb, Jerry Davis, Gib Munro, Evelyn Hankel, Dough Schlieski, Ed and Sylvia Betts, Kathleen Brady and so many more who showered our family with kindness.

We treasure this St. Mary's parish community, and always will.
