THE MODEL CULTURE OF THE AMAZING PLT

The model culture of the Amazing Parish Leadership Team (PLT) is like that of Jesus, always choosing Peter, James, and John to be with him whenever a great redemptive event was to happen. For example, the transfiguration on the mountain (confer Mt. 17:1) and the agony in the Garden of Gethsemane (confer Mk. 14: 32-42).

Likewise, in the Amazing Parish culture setup, the pastor choses 3 to 5 non-advisory parishioners to build a Parish Leadership Team (PLT) whose primary collective and individual responsibility is to create and promote a culture of prayer with itself, staff, and parish community. The PLT also organizes healthy parish programs, and supports the staff, ministries, committees, and organizations in the parish. They also are working on evangelization within and outside the parish community.

The Model Culture of the Amazing Parish structure looks like this:

PASTOR → PLT → PARISH OFFICE → PARISHIONERS → THE WORLD

This is what forms a culture of a healthy, Amazing Parish. As St. Mary, Star of the Sea Parish and St. Francis De Sales Mission Church, let us all come together as disciples of Jesus to build and promote a culture of prayer, Eucharistic worship and adoration, healthy diverse community, discipleship and go out to evangelize the world.

Re-written from an article in the Catholic Sentinel: Sept 9, 1904

The cornerstone for the new church in Astoria, St. Mary, Star of the Sea, was laid on August 19, 1902. The Most Reverend Alexander Christie, Archbishop of Oregon officiated assisted by Rev. Charles J. O'Reilly, the Rev. Dr. John McNally, Rev. John Waters, and Rev. Arthur Lane, pastor. A large group of people were in attendance. The architect of the church was Joseph Jacobberger of Portland, and the contractor was Julius Jacobs of Astoria.

** Please note that in last weekend's bulletin, the new St. Mary, Star of the Sea gym was dedicated in 1948, and not 1978. **
