Highlights...

In 1963, Started 4th grade with 4 other siblings that grew to a family of 7 children that attended Star of the Sea.

In 1974, My brothers Mike and Pat along with Andy Bugas were Altar Servers for the 100th anniversary celebration under Fr. Charles Borho. In 1980, I taught Rock Room and coached volleyball.

In 1998, I coached or assisted with basketball, track, and softball with my mom/brothers. My stepdad Charlie Turina was the Athletic Director, which I took over a couple of years while my daughter Brooke attended Star of the Sea. As an only child her siblings were her classmates where she developed a strong sense of self. Deby Howe, Betsy Gaynor, Chris Windnagle, Mary Jo Gruhlkey, Sharon Davis and ChrisLynn Taylor were instrumental in making the 7th & 8th grade trip to Washington DC and a visit to Parliament in Victoria a reality in 2001/2002.

My mom and dad Turina were always giving of themselves to strengthen our parish. My husband Ray and I are volunteers for St. Vincent de Paul Society, which was started by mom who told Jill Stokeld she had a vision for this ministry when they were at an 8th grade camping trip to Canada in 1981. 43 years later, Jill who still serves, was awarded the Vincent de Paul – Portland Council 2024 VINCENTIAN OF THE YEAR. Dolores Sharp received the BLESSED FREDERIC AWARD for her service beginning in 1993.
