Memory from Jane Morfitt Sporre

My grandpa, Ed Noonan, was present for the laying of the cornerstone of St. Mary’s which began many memories over the years.

Mrs. Crawford, my second-grade teacher, had a brother who was a priest and classmate of my mom. He told me that if I had to use my fingers to add, I should put my hands in my pockets. I still do to this day.

Grandpa Noonan built the house that Dave Pollard lives in now and also the Norblad/Noonan home by the church. My mom and Oney Camberg were Star of the Sea classmates and according to my mom, Oney was as generous as a young child as she was as an adult.

Another fun fact: After the big fire of 1923, the nuns lived at my mom’s house. My mom and her sister were not amused.
