October 27, 1962

We were without electrical power from Friday evening to Sunday afternoon. Compared to reports from other parts of Washington and Oregon, Astoria escaped with little damage.

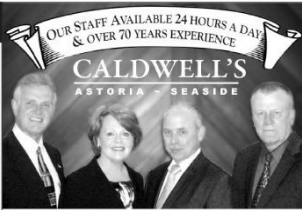

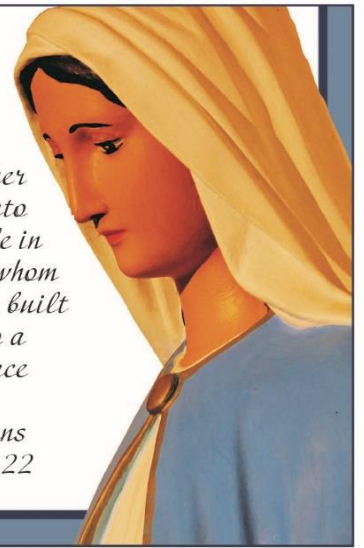
