Memories from Sandra S. Baker

Mother of 12 children

Memories of Astoria's St. Mary, Star of the Sea parish and school began in the fall of 1972. We enrolled 5 of our children at Star of the Sea School. The parish was very welcoming as we met priests and parishioners. Many have now been longtime dear friends. I joined St. Joseph's circle and have enjoyed our activities such as bake sales, fall bazaars, and cleaning the church. Some of us try to meet monthly for lunch with memories and updates on our families.

In 1983, I was hired to teach the 4th grade until 1986. We were fortunate to have had teachers who loved their students and wanted to give them a good education and a Catholic faith background. Two people who kept the school fine tuned were Jerry Davis and Nancy Ames. Jerry, custodian and parent, had the most organized shop in the lower level of the building. It was a case of "you name it and he would have it". He was always ready to help the teachers and most importantly, kept the school in tip-top shape, clean and safe. Nancy Ames, the school secretary, was always there for the paperwork, the phones and the bandaids. She was sympathetic to the needs of all.
