Memories from Catherine (Kitty) Munro

My grandfather, Micheal Lawrence Moran, from Dublin sailed from Dublin around Cape Horn, landing in Astoria in 1888. He jumped ship and the Oneys family who lived off Highway 26 hid him until the ship sailed. They helped him get his citizenship. When he got established, he sent for his wife Lucy Hunt Moran in 1891. She came through Ellis Island. In 1898 he went to Alaska during the Klondike Gold Rush and lost everything. They had 5 children, and my father was third in line. He was born in September 1898 and baptized on Christmas Day at St. Mary, Star of the Sea Church. My grandfather worked on the Columbia and Willamette Rivers and helped organize the old Columbia River Bar Pilots Association. The family moved to Portland in 1903, and my grandfather continued work as a bar pilot until he retired in 1934 as Captain Micheal Lawrence Moran.

My father and mother had 9 children. I was the middle one and spent many summers at Sunset Beach with my siblings. As an adult, I moved to Astoria in 1986 with my husband Gib and 2 grandchildren, Erin and Leslie whom we adopted because of the death of their mother. Both granddaughters graduated from Star of the Sea School. In 1990 when Donna Van Velzer retired from the lunch program, Gib and I took over for 10 years. Gib cooked for the auction dinners, St. Patrick's Day dinners and Shrove Tuesday pancake dinners. He was noted for his cinnamon rolls. Gib passed to the Lord in 2011, and I am still a member of St. Mary, Star of the Sea.


